Dear Parents of Third Graders:

We are very excited to present you with the opportunity to maintain and even build upon your child's education over the summer. Through the tireless efforts of our school's very own instructional committee they have come up with a dynamic and exciting program. In only fifteen to twenty minutes a day this summer your soon to be fourth grader will have the opportunity to advance their knowledge of grammar, math and language. In this packet you will find a SummerTimeTickler with one page of work per day for each weekday of the summer.

Why? We believe that students tune out academically if there is no mental stimulation. We also know that they are capable of this work and do not want them to lose it before starting fourth grade.

How do I sell it to my child? We suggest that you allow the incentives for following through with their lessons sell themselves. Please read the inside cover of the Tickler and see what sort of fun can be had if they spend just fifteen minutes a day using their brain.

We have included an answer guide for you to evaluate their work. Please initial the Tickler daily as work is completed. Mistakes should be corrected. It is advisable to hold onto the books and then distribute them to your child at a designated time each day. One of the things I am most excited about in the Tickler is the Bible verse. Each day your child will be in the Word. Use these great discussion verses to help them to a greater understanding of our Savior. The Bible section was not designed for memory work, but instead as a daily "tickler" and discussion tool.
