# Health Requirements for the 2018-2019 School Year

# Physical Examination is required for students prior to entering:

Preschool Kindergarten Sixth grade (6<sup>th</sup>) Ninth grade (9<sup>th</sup>)

# **Immunization requirement:**

All students must show proof of basic immunizations and **required** boosters. <u>New requirements:</u> **Meningococcal vaccine** for entering into **6**<sup>th</sup> **and 12**<sup>th</sup> **grade.** 

An Exclusion date of October 15<sup>th</sup>, 2018 has been established by the State of Illinois to meet the requirements. If records are not submitted by October 15<sup>th</sup>, 2018, the student will be excluded from school until proof is presented.

# **Dental Examination requirement:**

Kindergarten
Second grade (2<sup>nd</sup>)
Sixth grade(6<sup>th</sup>)

These students are required to have an oral health exam prior to May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2018. Examinations must be performed by a licensed dentist, and they must sign the Proof of School Dental Examination Form. Failure to submit proof of the dental exam may result in a hold of the student's report card.

# **Eye Examination requirement:**

Kindergarten and any student enrolling for the first time in an Illinois school are required to have an eye exam. Examinations must be performed by a licensed optometrist or medical doctor who performs eye exams. Students are required to have an eye exam prior to **October 15**<sup>th</sup>, **2018. Failure to submit proof of the eye exam may result in a hold of the student's report card.** 

# **Exemptions to this policy:**

A Certificate of Religious Exemption Form must be completed for students entering into Kindergarten, 6<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> grades who are requesting to waive immunizations due to religious beliefs. The certificate must be completed and signed by a physician and submitted by **October 15<sup>th</sup>**, 2018.
